**DRUE HEINZ SCHOLARSHIP**

(one award of one year's duration to support a student on a taught or research course in the Humanities)

Open to all graduate applicants for courses in the Humanities in which Worcester College admits students and who specify Worcester College as their first choice college. Preference is given to international applicants. The scholarship will provide funding for one year only up to a maximum of £10,000 per annum towards the full cost of fees and maintenance and includes certain SCR dining rights.

**Application Process**

Applicants must submit the following by email to the Graduate Officer ([graduate.enquiries@worc.ox.ac.uk](mailto:graduate.enquiries@worc.ox.ac.uk)) by the closing date:

- a completed application cover sheet (this can be downloaded from the College website at <http://www.worc.ox.ac.uk/applying/graduates/graduate-scholarships>)
- an up-to-date Curriculum Vitae;
- a covering letter stating their reasons for applying for the particular course and providing information about applications they have made to relevant funding bodies.

The selection committee will also take into account the references provided in support of the applicant's University application for graduate study.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all application material is submitted by the deadline; incomplete applications will not be considered.

**The closing date for all application material is Friday 1 March 2024.** All applications will receive an acknowledgement; if you have not received this by Friday 8 March 2024, please follow up to confirm receipt of your application.

The College is an equal opportunity employer. Decisions will be made on the basis of the written submissions and references; interviews will not be held. It is hoped that the successful candidate will be notified by 1 June 2024.
