(LAW)**

FRANCIS REYNOLDS LAW SCHOLARSHIP

(one award of one year's duration to support a student on a taught Law course)

Open to all graduate applicants for taught Law courses in which Worcester College admits students. The scholarship will provide funding for one year only, worth between £10,000 - £15,000, towards the full cost of fees and maintenance. Preference is given to existing or past Worcester College students, and to those wishing to study the BCL.

Application Process

Applicants must submit the following by email to the Graduate Officer (graduate.enquiries@worc.ox.ac.uk) by the closing date:

- a completed application cover sheet (this can be downloaded from the College website at <http://www.worc.ox.ac.uk/applying/graduates/graduate-scholarships>)
- an up-to-date Curriculum Vitae;
- a covering letter stating their reasons for applying for the particular course and providing information about applications they have made to relevant funding bodies.

The selection committee will also take into account the references provided in support of the applicant's University application for graduate study.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all application material is submitted by the deadline; incomplete applications will not be considered.

The closing date for all application material is Friday 7 March 2025. All applications will receive an acknowledgement; if you have not received this by Friday 14 March 2025, please follow up to confirm receipt of your application.

The College is an equal opportunity employer. Decisions will be made on the basis of the written submissions and references; interviews will not be held. It is hoped that the successful candidate will be notified by 1 June 2025.
