Two Junior Research Fellowships in the Sciences (Non-Stipendiary)
Tilleard-Cole Junior Research Fellowship in Psychiatry/Neuroscience (Non-Stipendiary)

The College proposes to elect to two Junior Research Fellowships in the Sciences (open to all subjects in the Sciences) and to the Tilleard-Cole Junior Research Fellowship in Psychiatry/Neuroscience, all for a period of two years from 1 October 2025. The Fellows will not receive a stipend from the College, but will be members of the Senior Common Room, entitled to lunch and dine free of charge (when the kitchens are open). The College is home to a thriving community of Research Fellows, Honorary and Emeritus Fellows. The recent appointment of two Heads of Research is part of a wider commitment to fostering a lively and supportive research environment, and the provision of support and mentoring to early career researchers. The College supports a range of research activities including seminars, workshops, public lectures, round-table discussions, and interdisciplinary approaches to research and publication that address a public audience.

The College regrets that it cannot provide study rooms or accommodation. Junior Research Fellows are not members of the Governing Body, but may, if invited, undertake a limited amount of teaching for Worcester College. If they do so, they will be paid at the regular outside tuition rate.

The successful applicants will be expected to carry out research in Oxford. The Fellowship may be held in conjunction with a funded research posts in a University Department.
